

Safety First!

These guidelines are meant to keep all Highlanders safe when arriving to and leaving school campus.

Drivers

- BEST – park in an open stall and meet your Highlander at the flag pole; then walk them safely to your car
- Follow the rules of the road
- Avoid parking on 144th
- See the inside travel pattern map for directions on how to pick up and drop off

Bike Riders, Skateboarders, Scooters

- Students entering grades 4, 5, 6 must have a permission slip on file
- Students must wear a proper fitting helmet
- Students must follow the rules of the road
- Students must arrive and leave promptly
- Students must cross streets at the crossing guard stations

Walkers

- Follow the safe walking paths identified by the District
- Students are encouraged to walk in groups;
- Parents/Guardians are encouraged to escort their children
- Students must arrive and leave promptly
- Students must cross the streets at the crossing guard stations

Bus Riders

- Follow bus safety rules as identified by the District
- Riders must behave in a safe manner at bus stops

Arrival and Departure School Safety Expectations



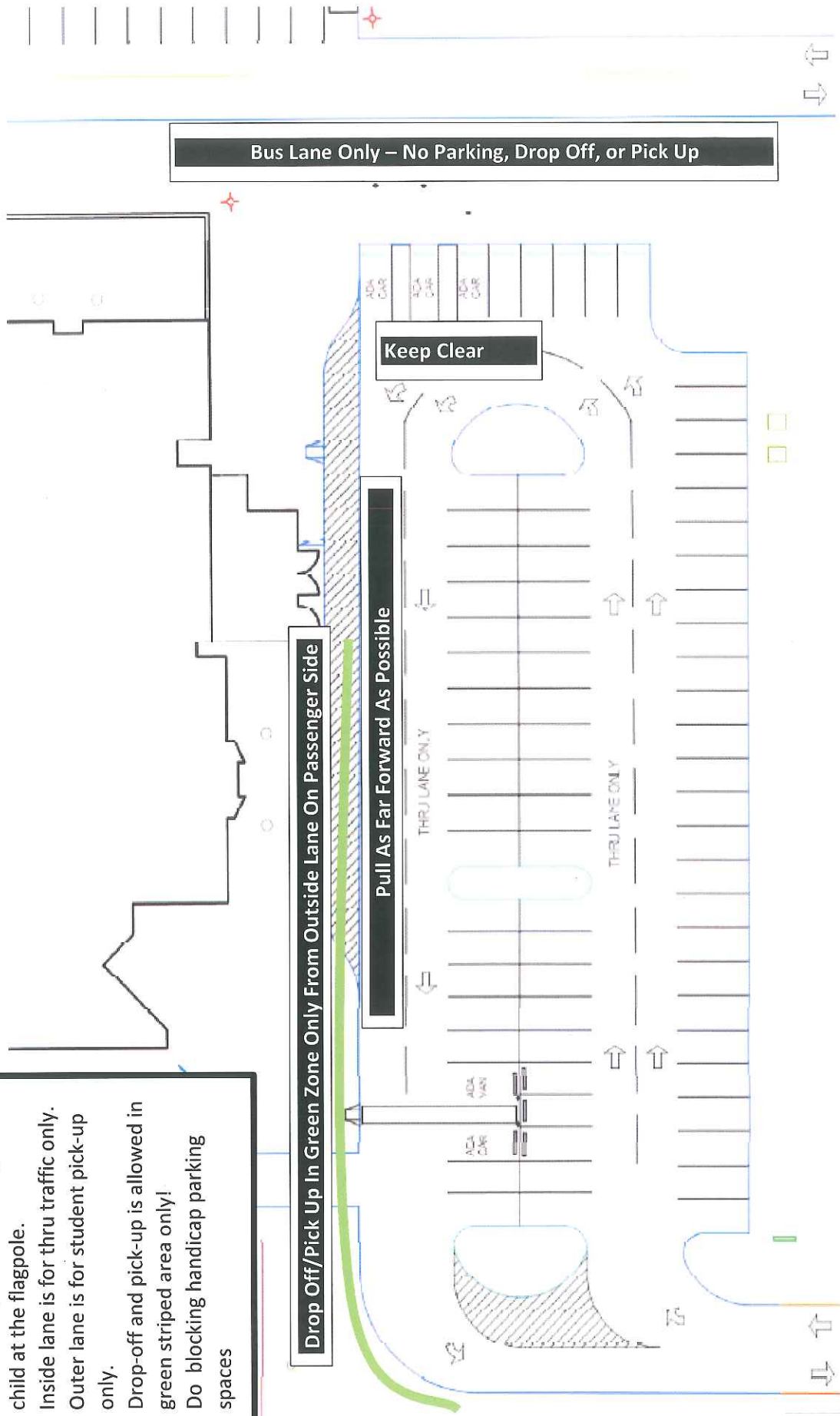
The safety of each student is a community responsibility. Every person must do their part to ensure that arrival and dismissal routines promote safety, efficiency, and systematic procedures.

Hunt Elementary Safe Pick Up and Drop Off Map

We appreciate your help in abiding by these drop-off and pick-up guidelines:

- 1) Avoid parking on 144th St. E.
- 2) It's best to park and meet your child at the flagpole.
- 3) Inside lane is for thru traffic only.
- 4) Outer lane is for student pick-up only.
- 5) Drop-off and pick-up is allowed in green striped area only!
- 6) Do blocking handicap parking spaces
